Nursery Schools** in Birmingham.

Working in partnership with University
College Birmingham, BNSTA is offering
School Direct Teacher Training; an unstaried
3-7 route which, on successful completion, will
lead to a **PGCE at Masters Level and
Qualified Teacher Status**.



Commencing in September 2017, the
programme has a prime focus on the **Early Years**.
On successful completion you will receive
Qualified Teacher Status, which will give you
the opportunity to gain employment in the
Foundation Stage and Key Stage One settings as a
Newly Qualified Teacher.

There are **8** places available and
interviews will begin in November/ December 2016.

Successful applicants will be **trainee teachers**
from the start of the programme.
As a trainee teacher you will be training in the
Autumn term in an Early Years Setting (host
school).

In the **Spring term** you will be based in a
primary school, within the Key Stage 1 phase.
In the **final term** you will return to the host
school to complete your training.

- You will attend UCB 1 day a week for a
taught module.
- There are 3 modules - 20 master credits
per module

**On successful completion you will gain a
PGCE and QTS with 60 Master credits**
